The time is coming to focus on some of the amazing talent within our own club. And you get to decide who those featured presenters are.

Have you seen a photo presented in competition this year that absolutely blew you away? Do you want to learn what went into the creation of your favorite images? Do you want to help honor the talent that inspires you in your own work? Here's what you do:

- 1. Browse this season's <u>Competition Gallery</u> on the SJCC Website and choose the images you'd love to learn more about. The score it received in competition doesn't matter. The impact it had on you does. **Any competition photo from December to May of this year is eligible for nomination.** (The high scoring photos from our May competition will be posted within a day or two of the meeting.)
- 2. Email us a list of your top picks (up to 10) to info@sjcameraclub.org by May 22. The earlier we receive your nominations the better, as that gives us the ability to give the clear front-runners more time to prepare their presentations.

Include the following information in your email:

- Subject Line of your email: Behind the Lens Nominations
- For each photo nominated include: the month of the competition and whether color or monochrome (so that we can locate it), the maker's name, and the title of the photo. Note: clicking on the thumbnail in the gallery will reveal a larger view along with name and title.

Send to info@sjcameraclub.org by May 22.

We will invite the makers of the most nominated photos to speak briefly and answer questions about the approach, inspiration and creation of their notable work at our June 10th presentation meeting.

Frank Smith – The Art of Photographing People There is more to it than saying "Cheese"

Frank is fascinated by people everywhere he goes. As an outgoing individual, Frank loves to engage with and then photograph people. However, not everyone wants their picture taken and it is also considered taboo in some cultures – but Frank has managed to overcome the challenge!

Photographing people is not the true art, the true art is convincing people to let Frank photograph them. Just like in any photograph, lighting is key and sometimes it takes a little persuasion and some kind words to get just the right shot.

As an Olympus shooter Frank finds that many of the benefits of the system is its size. The micro four-thirds system is much less intimidating than some of the other cameras and it allows Frank to get up close to people.

Frank looks to capture the culture and tell a story based on the images he takes. He has been fortunate to photograph people all over the world and with each image the story may be slightly different.

Frank will share his learned skill at defusing resistance, creating the shot, generating interest and sharing the image with the individual.

- 1. Email 2 or 3 Jpeg images to info@sjcameraclub.org. Make sure the file name has your name and the image title. Example: Ansel-Adams_Moonrise-At-Yosmite.jpg. *Please email your images no later than 24 hours before the meeting.*
- 2. Each meeting will be limited to 12 photographers for critiquing selected on a first come first serve basis. The meeting is open to all members, so, even if your work isn't being critiqued, you are welcome to come and watch and learn. If we have a large response, we will try to schedule additional sessions.

3. Since we may not be able to get to all of your images, please specify the order you'd like them reviewed so that we can prioritize the requests.
