Architecture and Sculpture at Princeton University

Led by Scott Malin, AIA

Join architect Scott Malin on a visit to the campus of Princeton University to tour and photograph one of the best collections of modern architecture and sculpture anywhere. We will be there during the Fall Break, so we should have a relatively easy time finding parking, strolling the grounds, and enjoying our visit. Hopefully, besides some great photographic opportunities on the campus, we might also be able to enter some of the buildings to enjoy their interior design as well.

Some of the architectural works we may see include designs by Frank Gehry

who designed the Guggenheim Bilboa, Rafael Vinoly who designed the Kimmel Center, I.M. Pei who designed the Louvre Pyramid, Robert Venturi who designed Franklin Court in Phila. and works by many others. In terms of sculpture, there are many great works including designs by Calder, Serra, Maya Lin, Picasso, and others.
