David DesRochers – The Art of Flower Photography

Whether photographing flowers in your garden or in a mountain meadow, there are techniques every level of photographer can use to create a photo worth hanging on your wall. This program is designed to help you understand digital

SLR camera settings and how to use them to manage light and sharpness. David will also cover the basics of composition and will share a few creative ideas that you can use to change an ordinary subject into a work of art.

David's passion for nature photography was sparked by a trip to Glacier National Park in the summer of 2000. Since then, he and his wife Cathy have traveled the world to witness and photograph the wonders of nature.

David is a member of the North American Nature Photography Association and has written several articles for Nature Photographer Magazine. His photographs have won several awards and have been published in books, magazines and on calendars.

David is an accomplished public speaker and has been inspiring photographers for over 15 years. He has been a featured speaker at photography clubs and events including the New England Camera Club Council Annual Conference (2014 & 2016), the Connecticut Association of Photographers, New Jersey Audubon's Birding Festival, and the New York City Sierra Club. His experience judging photo competitions has taken him as far as Budoia, Italy to judge the Bio Photo Contest. In 2014, David was awarded the New Jersey Federation of Camera Clubs Citation, the highest individual honor bestowed by the Federation. He teaches photography for The New Jersey Audubon Society's digital photography workshop series and is available for individual instruction.

- 1. Email 2 or 3 Jpeg images to info@sjcameraclub.org. Make sure the file name has your name and the image title. Example: Ansel-Adams_Moonrise-At-Yosmite.jpg.
- 2. Each meeting will be limited to 12 photographers for critiquing selected on a first come first serve basis. The meeting is open to all members, so, even if your work isn't being critiqued, you are welcome to come and watch and learn. If we have a large response, we will try to schedule additional sessions.
- 3. Since we may not be able to get to all of your images, please specify the order you'd like them reviewed so that we can prioritize the requests.

Everyone from beginner to professional photographers can benefit from a detailed, constructive and non-judgmental critique of their work. We encourage you to submit some images.
