WORKSHOP - Slow Shutter Light Painting Sunday, September 10 at 7PM

Medford United Methodist Church, Bowker Hall, 2 Hartford Road, Medford NJ **Note that this is SUNDAY evening.**

Explore Light Painting Photography. This photographic technique where the artist opens the shutter of a camera for an extended period of time and uses various light sources to create color and design within the frame. There is no photo editing. Light painting images are created in real time and captured in the camera in one single photographic frame.

We will begin the workshop reviewing the work of inspiring light painting artists and then practice what we learned. The techniques are fun and easy to do. This is a hands-on workshop! Tripod and cable release are required.

Monthly Presentation: Thursday, September 14 at 7pm via Zoom Photographing Birds - Lisa Cuchara

Birds are everywhere! You can find, observe, study, photograph, and enjoy birds in your yard, at the beach, in the woods, etc. But it can be hard to capture their grandeur, colorful personality, and interesting behaviors with your camera. The program will go over some of the gear, techniques, technologies, and expertise you need to craft stunning bird images and tell stories with your camera. While birds are very interesting creatures, it is not so easy to photograph them. Birds do not usually pose for you, and it can often seem like you cannot get close enough to take stunning photographs of them. This presentation will provide tips for getting better bird images.
