

Photography Tip! Ever wonder how how to get a starburst with points of light like street lamps or the sun? Put your camera in manual or aperture priority mode and set your lens to a small aperture like f/11 or f/16. and shoot away Wider angle lenses tend to make a better starburst pattern than telephotos.
