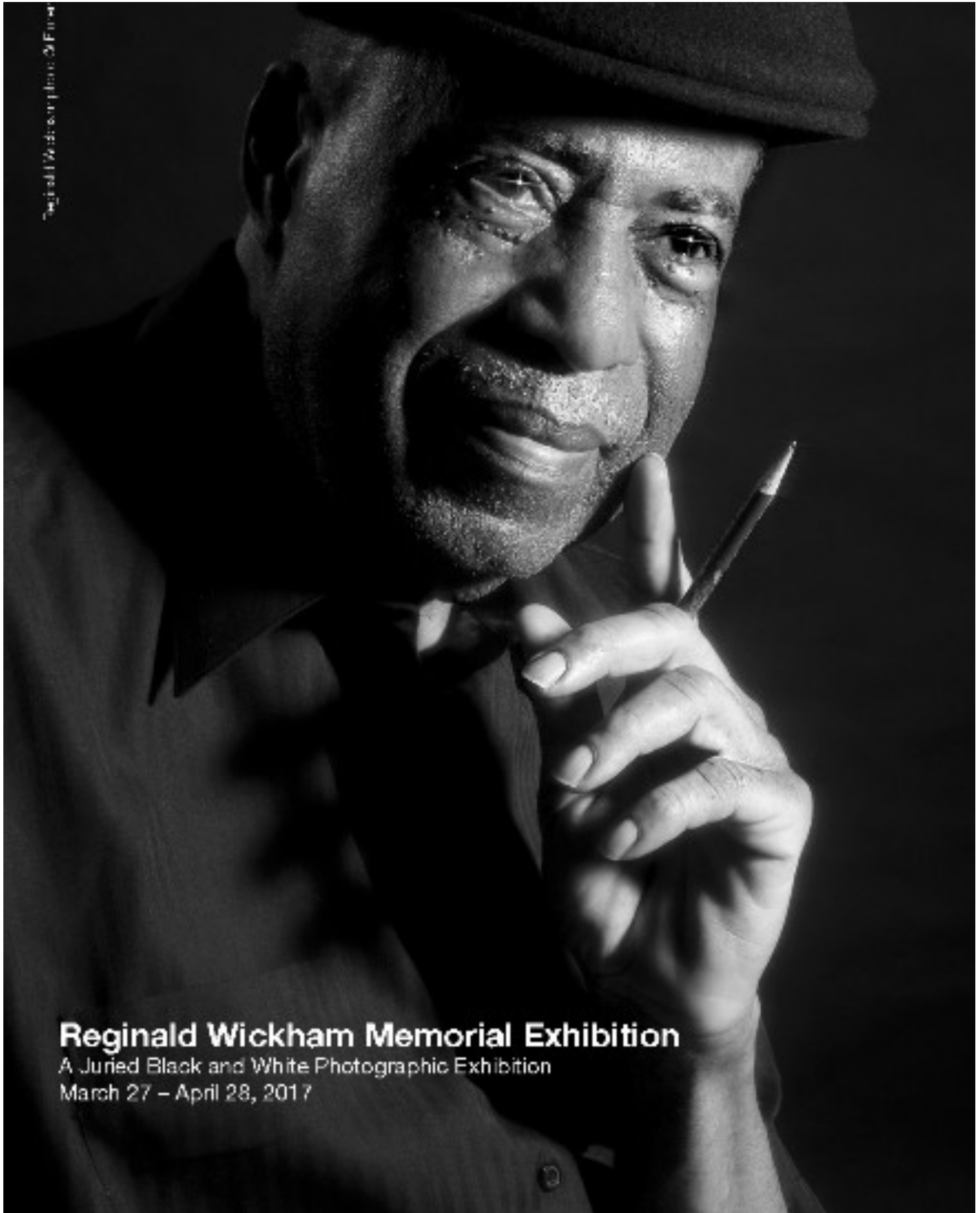

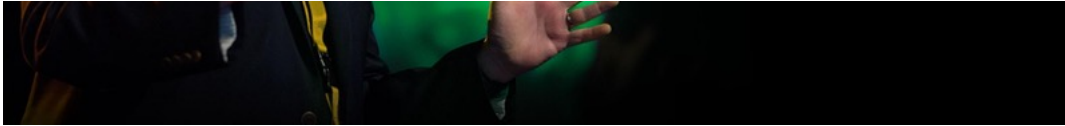

Now that we're getting closer to the start of [Essential Studio Lighting: Light it, Capture it, Retouch it](#) on March 12, I wanted to check in and give you a little more information.

Lead by experienced instructor and photographer Jeff Shaffer, this comprehensive 10 session class meets every other Sunday over the course of five months, allowing students to learn at their own pace.

Students will learn how to expertly use professional lighting equipment, studio electronic flash, small portable flash, incandescent lighting, and natural light to illuminate a matter what equipment they have (or don't have).

In addition to developing a solid foundation in lighting, students will edit, process, and retouch their images using Adobe Photoshop, Bridge, and Lightroom. As an Adobe Creative Cloud member, you will receive a 10% discount on the class fee.
