

Photoshop Elements, presented by Barbara Doreste

December 8, 10am - 12pm, Medford Leas, Holly Room

The Adobe Photoshop Elements workshop will address the beginner/intermediate photographer, as well as those new to Adobe Elements, who wish to learn the basic functions of the program. We will discuss the critical enhancements for color and lighting, along with the applications of the tools in the toolbar. If time and interest permit, the class will also cover more advanced editing processes including the use of layers and non-destructive editing. A laptop with an installation of Elements and your photos would be helpful, but not necessary. An outline and notes for the workshop will be distributed during the class.

Field Trip: Edwin B. Forsythe Wildlife Refuge and Barnegat Lighthouse

Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge, protects more than 47,000 acres of Southern New Jersey coastal habitats. We will be looking for Snow Geese and any other winter residents we may be fortunate enough to encounter. We'll be driving around the 8-mile wildlife loop but will be in and out of our cars as we spot subjects to shoot. Please dress appropriately for the weather.

After our Forsythe visit, we will be making an excursion to the Barnegat Lighthouse on Long Beach Island. While there we will not only be able to get some photos of the Lighthouse, but also some of the water fowl that winter in the surrounding waters.
