Presentation Program: Thursday September 23

Is it a 6 or a 9? What Judges Look For by Henry Rowan

Henry is a national award-winning photographer and the executive director of the Pennsylvania Center for Photography in Doylestown. In addition to being a working professional photographer, Henry is a frequent lecturer and judge throughout the region and teaches a variety of workshops. His work is frequently on display at galleries and shows and he has gained a following for his distinctive style of photography.

Competition Night: Tuesday, September 17

Digital: Open

 Monochrome Prints: Centered – Position your main subject in the center of the frame. Put what you leaned from Henry Rowan's presentation to work starting with this competition. If this is the first time you are competing and aren't sure how to upload your photographs, there are videos on our website that show you how to do it.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: OUR NEW COMPETITION RULES ARE OUR OLD COMPETITION RULES!

Last season we experimented with a new way of scoring with the idea of making the competitions better. Well, the the statistics didn't show that it did, so this year we will be returning to our previous system where our judges will pick one Judge's Choice in each group and that photograph will receive one extra point. So, if you score a 9 and the judge rewards your work with the Judge's Choice, you score will be a 10. There will be no Second or Third Place, or Honorable Mention awards granted. This should help streamline the judging process and result in a small bit of time saving.

One Other Rule Change

We changed the maximum print size from 20"x20" to 22"x22". This is done for our members who like printing on larger paper sizes, like 17"x22" which is a standard photo paper. So now you can think big with your photography and print big too.

Camera Basics with Vinny Giannino

You've heard the expression "Everyone's a Photographer until... M." The 'M' on top of your camera stands for manual. Learn how to control your camera, where you dial in precisely the exposure you envision. By exposing everyone to the 'exposure triangle' along with what each part does, this class will take the anxiety out of the equation and put the creativity back in. Please bring your cameras and manuals for reference. Vinny will have helpers who are familiar with Nikon, Canon, Sony and Olympus systems.
