
We Are Open for the Holidays

Workshop: Saturday, December 10, 10am - noon Introduction to Portraiture, presented by Bob Laramie

Medford United Methodist Church, 2 Hartford Road, Medford

Learn tips to turn your snapshots into professional quality portraits.

In this two part basic beginner to intermediate program we will view a short slide show explaining some of the basics of good portraiture including a concept Bob calls one lighting pattern and three views of the face. The presentation will include examples of classic portrait poses and simple lighting which can be either available light, flash or continuous LED sources.

Other items discussed will be the importance of pose and expression, different types of lighting equipment and quality and direction of light. Handouts will include: A Chart illustrating most desirable views of the face and list of suggestions to correct basic facial flaws.

A live model shooting demonstration will follow the slide show.
